Asylum Seekers & Refugee Ministry 尋求庇護者及難民事工



An asylum seeker is a person who fled from their country but is not accepted yet as refugee. Refugees and Asylum Seekers are different. Universal declaration of human rights specifies that "everyone has the right to seek and enjoy asylum abroad from persecution". They aim to become refugees in order to apply to countries where they can settle. The UNHCR is the government agency in Hong Kong that looks after their application in processing their papers. The latest statistics showed there are approximate 13,000 Asylum Seekers (inclusive of asylum seekers, refugees, and torture claimants) in Hong Kong. The success rate for their application is very low. Often times, they stay in Hong Kong for many years. Additionally, they are not permitted

to work according to Hong Kong law, any violation may result in penitentiary.

尋求庇護者是指逃離本國,但仍未獲接納為難民的人士。難民與尋求庇護者的名稱卻是不同。根據《世界人權宣言》的定義,「當你受到迫害便有權在他國尋求並享受庇身之所」。尋求庇護者的目的是獲得難民身份,以便向其他國家申請居住權。聯合國難民署是設於香港的政府機構,負責替尋求庇護者處理文件以助他們申請。最新的統計資料顯示,香港大約有13,000名尋求庇護者及難民。可是,尋求庇護者的申請成功率極低。他們通常要在香港等待多年。並且,政府嚴禁他們工作否則觸犯法例而被判監禁一段較長的時期。

Foreword

New Wine Ministries Hong Kong continues with its vision and mission to love and care for those who are disadvantaged and rejected within our community, including the homeless, poverty stricken and those who suffer from cancer and other serious health problems.

These past few years, emerging from the shadow of Covid, have been particularly challenging. We strive to continue to provide financial assistance, givings of food, clothing and essential personal supplies. We also assist with the teaching of English while providing emotional and spiritual support through fellowship gatherings for our asylum seekers. As for the cancer patients, we offer healing programs based on Christian faith.

STATEMENT

This year, we celebrate twelve years of New Wine Ministries Hong Kong. Founded by Reverend Noreen Siu-Richards and incorporated in September 2011, New Wine Ministries became a non-profit, non-governmental organisation in February 2014 and became a member of the Hong Kong Council for Social Services in 2015.

We started our ministries at our premises in Wong Chuk Hang in 2011. At the start, we received about 20 to 30 weekly asylum seekers who came for hymn singing, talks, fellowship, a hot meal as well as receiving a monthly living subsidy to assist with their daily living. In 2017, the group increased to 70 and we expanded to include a kitchen equipped to offer them a sit-down hot meal. We have, since then, expanded to give them food packages, clothing and basic necessities and personal supplies.

More recently, the number of asylum seekers at out Ministry has grown to 170. They receive only minimal support from the government and are not allowed to work. They look for NGOs like ourselves for extra support.

Besides the asylum seekers, New Wine Ministries Hong Kong also provide emotional and spiritual support to cancer patients. We invite them to our premise for healing programs as well as fellowship groups and social gatherings.

The annual funding we raise in 2023 will help us maintain support for both groups as well as expanding to include more people and provide additional services for these two communities.

Equally honoured and grateful am I to have so many honourable guests to be present in support of our cause and to celebrate this 12th years anniversary of 'New Wine Ministries Hong Kong's Sing for Joy' charity gala 2023. We would like to thank those who supported us but could not be here this evening.

We are truly blessed and we are grateful that all Covid restrictions are lifted so we are able to enjoy all the programs to follow. We have but one purpose tonight and that is to raise as much funds in support to our asylum seekers and refugees as well as helping people suffering from cancer or have survived cancer.

The recent Ukraine War and the most recent uprising in Israel showed us daily large influx of people by the millions seeking asylum to other countries as they face death or torture if they stay in these countries. Hong Kong is a place of peace and safety in comparison to those war-zone like countries. We do have those escaped to Hong Kong due to political, economic or religious reason. Hong Kong has a no-visa entry policy that attract those who want to escape quickly. But little do they know once they enter they can be stuck here for years and years.

Existing we have around 15,000 asylum seekers and refugees in Hong Kong. As the government's financial assistance are below their subsistence, they look to NGO groups like us and others to help in their livelihood. Most often this group has been neglected, rejected and dejected by our community at large. Usually a 4-6 persons shared housing near the Tuen Mun or near the mainland border is what they could afford with a mere \$1500 per month housing allowance. A further food coupon of \$1200 per month and \$300 travelling allowance are all they got each month.

New Wine Ministries are equally compassionate towards the cancer patients. Throughout the past 12 years, we have offered them emotional and spiritual healing which often their lives are transformed and their illness recovered.

We thank you again for tonight and May God blesses you abundantly!
